

## BEGINNER QUILTING CLASS

### Supplies List

You will be making a 3-block wall hanging. Two blocks will be patchwork and one will be machine appliqué.

1 fat quarter (dark) (for 9-patch)

1 fat quarter (medium dark) (star)

1/3 yd. to coordinate (medium light) (background of star and 9-patch)

1 ¼ yards of a third fabric that will coordinate for sashing, border, backing, and binding

1 fat quarter for background of appliqué block (light color)

1/8 yd. or scrap for stem and leaves (green)

18" x 46" batting

1 pkg. or scraps of Fast 2 Fuse or Heat & Bond Lite fusible for appliqué

Threads to match all fabrics

Walking foot for your machine (also called an even-feed foot)

Approx. 80 basting safety pins (usually curved) #1 or #2 size

Rotary cutter

24" rotary cutting ruler

### Beginner Runner/Wall Hanging Cutting Instructions

Blocks are 12 ½" (12" finished)

Sashing: cut 4 strips 2" x 12 ½"

Border: cut 2 strips 2" x 42 ½"

Backing: cut 18" x WOF

Binding: cut 3 strips 2 ½" x WOF. Cut off selvages
