

SUPPLY LIST - Fabulous Finishes Class 8/08:

sewing machine with ¼" foot and walking foot

quilting guide for your machine (optional)

masking tape, basting safety pins

binding clips

scissors, pins, quilting ruler, cutting mat (preferably 18" x 24"), rotary cutter

all-purpose thread (to match binding fabrics and placemat fabrics)

appliqué needles or sharps (for attaching bindings)

fabric (yardage is per placemat):

<u>Placemat 1:</u>	¾ yard of main fabric	1 – 13" x 14" rectangle of main fabric
	½ yard of accent 1 fabric	1 – 13" x 5 ½" rectangle of accent 1 fabric
	¾ yard backing fabric	1 – 14" x 20" backing
	4 – 14" x 20" batting	1 – 14" x 20" batting
<u>Placemat 2:</u>	¾ yard of main fabric	1 – 12 ½" x 12 ½" square of main fabric
	1 yard accent 2 fabric (includes bias binding)	2 – 3 ½" x 12 ½" rectangles accent 2 fabric
	¾ yard backing fabric	½ yard accent fabric (for bias binding)
	4 – 13" x 19" batting	1 – 13" x 19" backing
		1 – 13" x 19" batting
<u>Placemat 3:</u>	¼ yard of 4 different fabrics	12 assorted 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles
	6 – 2" strips for bindings	2 – 2" strips for bindings
	¾ yard backing fabric	1 – 13" x 19" backing
	4 – 13" x 19" batting	1 – 13" x 19" batting
<u>Placemat 4:</u>	½ yard main fabric (borders)	¼ yard main fabric (borders)
	¼ yard accent (borders)	1/8 yard accent (borders)
	¼ yard center fabric	1 – 6 ½" x 12 ½" rectangle for center
	¾ yard backing fabric	1 – 14" x 20" backing
	4 – 14" x 20" batting	1 – 14" x 20" batting

**If you want to make just 4 different placemats that coordinate (like samples) you will need the following yardage:

Main Fabric: ¾ yard

Accent 1 (for #1 & #3 & #4): ½ yard

Accent 2 (for #2 & #3): ¾ yard

Accent 3 (for #3): 1/8 yard

Accent 4 (for #4): ¼ yard

Backings: ¾ yard

Batting: 2 – 13" x 19" and 2 – 14" x 20"

PRELIMINARY CUTTING (to be done before class):

Cut (per placemat):

<u>Placemat 1:</u>	1 – 13" x 14" rectangle of main fabric
	1 – 13" x 5 ½" rectangle of accent 1 fabric
	1 – 14" x 20" backing
	1 – 14" x 20" batting

Placemat 2: 1 – 12 ½” x 12 ½” square of main fabric
2 – 3 ½” x 12 ½” rectangles accent 2 fabric
1 – 13” x 19” backing
1 – 13” x 19” batting
½ yard of accent 2 for bias binding (will cut in class)

Placemat 3: 12 assorted 3 ½” x 6 ½” rectangles (3 each of main, accent 1, accent 2,
Accent 3, and main fabrics)
2” x width of fabric accent 3 fabric (for bindings) -
Cut 2 strips for one placemat or 5 strips for four placemats
1 – 13” x 19” backing
1 – 13” x 19” batting

Placemat 4: 3” x width of fabric of main fabric (for outer borders) -
Cut 2 strips for one placemat or 5 strips for four placemats
1 ¼” x width of accent 3 (for inner borders) –
Cut 2 strips for one placemat or 5 strips for four placemats
1 – 6 ½” x 12 ½” of accent 4 (for center rectangle)
1 – 14” x 20” backing
1 – 14” x 20” batting
