

SUPPLY LIST: One-Block Wonders 8/08

sewing machine with ¼” foot
pins, quilting and flat flower head
quilting ruler with 30-degree angle mark
scissors, cutting mat (preferably 18” x 24”)
rotary cutter (with new blade) – the larger the better
all-purpose neutral colored thread for piecing
quilting thread
needles (for attaching bindings)
spray starch (optional)
“One-Block Wonders” book by Maxine Rosenthal (optional)

fabric (DO NOT PREWASH):

6 lengthwise repeats (24” to 27” repeat works best)

Note:

- Select fabrics with minimal background.
- Avoid fabrics with several smaller animals or design elements spaced evenly around fabric.
- Backgrounds that are not a solid color work best.
- Avoid stripes – swirls are better.
- Avoid fabrics with straight lines (like boxes around large designs in rows).
- The larger scale the print, the better.
- If you get different colors under the palm of your hand as you move it over the fabric, it’s a fabric that will work well.
