

Fabric Jewelry Wrapped Braided and Sewn- Supply List Quilt Shop Workshop

We will be making all five beads in the workshop, I will show you how to assemble each piece of jewelry, and I have listed the items needed for each technique under the project name. Most of these items are available at either bead stores or quilting stores.

You will need:

Copy of “Fabric Jewelry- Wrapped Braided and Sewn” By Heidi Pridemore

General Tools: Small flat paintbrush
 Container for water
 Extra Fine Sharpie
 Pencil
 X-acto Knife
 Awl
 Fabric Glue

Available at quilt shops:

Small scissors
Appliqué Pressing Sheet
Size 8 Straw or hand sewing needles
Tapestry needles
Mini Iron (clover)
Thread Heaven or bees wax
½ yard of fusible web such as Steam-a-Seam II
½ yard of heavy stabilizer such as Timtex or Craft-Tex
Rotary Cutter, small mat and ruler
Fabrics, fibers and buttons as listed for each project

Available at bead shops:

Crimp Pliers (optional)
Wire Cutters
Jewelers Cement such as Hypo cement
Needle Nose Pliers- Smooth
Round Nose Pliers
Findings, beads and wires as listed for each project

Other Supplies needed listed by project:

Rolled Beads and Necklace:

1. Fat 1/8 of your choice of 100% cotton fabrics – Best choices are batiks, small prints or textured
2. Three 1” glass or metal focus beads
3. One tube of #8 seed beads and one tube of #11 seed beads that match your fabric and focus beads
4. Clasp
5. Beading Wire
6. Two Crimp Beads

Bead Sandwich & Bracelet:

1. Fat 1/8 of your choice of 100% cotton fabrics – Best choices are batiks, small prints or textured.
2. One Tube of #8 seed beads to match you fabric (we used two fabrics and two compliment color seed beads, the choice is yours)
3. Beading or hand quilting threads that match
4. Sixteen 8mm round beads that match
5. Double strand clasp
6. Beading wire
7. Four Crimp beads

Covered Buttons & Bracelet:

1. Fat 1/8 of your choice of 100% cotton fabrics – Best choices are batiks, small prints or textured.
2. Nine 20mm smooth topped shank buttons
3. One tube of matching #8 seed beads
4. Matching beading or hand quilting threads

Square Knot Beads and Necklace:

1. 4' of 18 gauge half-hard, round sterling silver wire
2. 12 yards of rayon or specialty cord/yarn with a smooth finish
3. Fourteen sterling silver 6mm open jump rings
4. Sterling silver Lobster Clasp
5. Small piece of board to pin the piece to while working on it (I use a mouse pad with a built in wrist rest)

Layered Wool Beads:

1. Assorted piece of wool fabric- at least two complimentary colors (I will also have small pieces of wool available)
2. Four 5mm spacer beads
3. 22" piece of Sterling silver beading chain and crimp clasps or silk cord with bead caps and clasp
4. Eight Crimp beads

Simple 3-D Beads:

1. Assorted piece of wool fabric- at least two complimentary colors (I will also have small pieces of wool available)
2. Five 1/4" silver disk beads of bead caps
3. Five 3" head or eye pins-sterling silver
4. Seven sterling silver 6mm jump rings
5. One 7" piece of open link sterling silver chain
6. Clasp
